ITINERARY

The itinerary for the tour, with key activities, is below. On some days additional activities are possible, some at no extra cost, others at additional cost. Meals included are shown as Breakfast (B), Lunch (L) and Dinner (D.) The tour is limited in size to 16 guests, with bookings confirmed on receipt of a deposit.

Monday 8 March 2027 – Australia to Ho Chi Minh City (in flight meals)

Depart from Australia and fly direct to Ho Chi Minh City, or transit Hong Kong or another Asian city enroute to your destination. On arrival transfer to our hotel, and overnight Ho Chi Minh.

Tuesday 9 March 2027 – Ho Chi Minh City sightseeing (B/D)

Ho Chi Minh City is a fast-paced, sun-soaked metropolis where the energy of modern Vietnam collides with layers of history at every intersection. French colonial landmarks like Notre Dame Cathedral and the Central Post Office sit beside glass towers, while alleyways buzz with motorbikes, street food stalls, and the constant rhythm of daily life. Once known as Saigon, the city carries vivid memories of war in its museums, yet feels unmistakably future-focused, entrepreneurial, and young. From rooftop bars overlooking the Saigon River to plastic stools serving late-night bowls of hủ tiếu, Ho Chi Minh City is loud, warm, chaotic, and irresistibly alive. Wednesday 10 March 2027 – (B/D) Ho Chi Minh City and welcome aboard the Sjourney luxury train

Thursday 11 March 2027 – (B/L/D) Phan Thiet – Explore the Ancient Chams Culture

After lunch, journey to the historic Poshanu Cham Towers, perched gracefully atop a hill overlooking Phan Thiet. 

Settle into your cabin, perhaps with a book in hand, or simply gaze through the wide windows as Phu Yen's countryside gently recedes — rolling fields, distant mountains, and narrow village roads weaving together a final tapestry of the land you leave behind. As twilight deepens into night, the dining car beckons. Here, amidst the glow of soft lighting and the clinking of glasses, a beautifully curated dinner awaits. Each course is crafted to complement the day's experiences — elegant yet unpretentious, much like Phu Yen itself. Outside, the world passes by in a quiet blur; inside, the evening unfolds with the warmth of new friendships and the lingering sweetness of a day spent close to the heart of Vietnam. Saturday 13 March 2027 (B/L/D) – Quang Nam – Ancient Merchant Hub of South East Asia

After a leisurely breakfast on board, the day begins with a scenic jeep tour through Hoi An's peaceful countryside. Your adventure leads to Au Lac Wood Art, where you can immerse yourself in the traditional craft of woodblock painting. Guided by skilled artisans, you'll learn the intricate process of making your own design onto wood. This hands-on experience provides a deeper appreciation of the artistry and cultural significance of this local craft. The tour continues to the Thanh Ha Pottery Village, where you can witness the craftsmanship of local potters and even try your hand at shaping your own ceramic creation. This combination of activities offers a rich insight into the heritage and creativity of Hoi An's artisan communities. Savour the true flavours of the region with a home-hosted delicious lunch prepared at a local house. Relish dishes crafted from the freshest locally-sourced ingredients, a testament to the bounty of this fertile land. Lose yourself in Hoi An Ancient Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site where centuries of history unfold with every step. Your exploration begins at the heart of Hoi An's mercantile past — the bustling Hoi An Market. A whirlwind of sights, sounds, and intoxicating aromas, this market offers a captivating immersion into local life. Browse stalls overflowing with shimmering silks, intricately carved handicrafts, and a dazzling array of exotic spices. Continue your stroll through the enchanting Old Town, where time seems to stand still. Arrive at the Phuc Kien Chinese Assembly Hall, a magnificent architectural gem adorned with vibrant gates, mythical dragon statues, and ornate rooftops. Conclude your afternoon with a leisurely exploration of Hoi An's renowned handicraft shops and art galleries. Sunday 14 March 2027 (B/L/D) – Hue - discover the Magnificent of The Last Empire in Vietnam

Leaving the citadel, you continue by private van to Tu Duc

The journey leads next to Hue's Incense Village, where artisans shape cinnamon, agarwood, and lotus-infused incense with skillful, graceful hands. Here, tradition comes alive, inviting you to try crafting incense or weaving a conical hat from lotus leaves — a quiet, intimate connection to Hue's enduring spirit. A refined lunch follows at a local restaurant, where Hue's cuisine — blending royal elegance and rustic authenticity — offers a feast for both the senses and the soul. As afternoon light softens over Hue, it's time to return to the train. A final glimpse of riverside gardens and distant temple spires bids farewell to this poetic city. From your seat aboard the luxurious carriage, the scenery shifts: the Perfume River, mossy pagodas, and solemn mountains slowly fade. Monday 15 March 2027 (B/L/D) – Quang Binh – A Soft Adventure in Jungle and Caves

If you wish, join in a demonstration Vietnamese cooking class to discover the vibrant flavours and fresh, locally sourced ingredients that define the region's cuisine. Learn traditional cooking techniques and create dishes bursting with flavour. Enjoy your culinary creations in this idyllic setting. As the stars begin to emerge, the gentle sounds of nature orchestrate a symphony of peace, a perfect farewell to Quang Binh. Late in the evening, your journey continues as the train departs for Ninh Binh carrying you towards your next captivating chapter. Overnight aboard the SJourney Luxury Train.



Tuesday 16 March 2027 (B/L/D) – Ninh Binh – Explore the First Kingdom of Vietnam

Awaken to the splendour of Ninh Binh as dawn unfurls, with a sumptuous breakfast served in the lavish confines of your luxury train. Each dish, a testament to refined culinary craft, sets a distinguished tone for the day's journey. The journey transitions seamlessly from the comfort of the train to the serene embrace of Trang An's emerald waters. Here, aboard a sampan, you are invited to navigate through a beautiful landscape. Amidst the grandeur of towering limestone cliffs and lush greenery, this journey offers an intimate glimpse into the heart of nature's splendour.



The narrative of the day continues as you arrive at Hoa Lu, Vietnam's ancient capital. Step back in time amidst the dramatic limestone peaks, where the legacy of the Dinh and Le dynasties lives on through temples and historical sites. Amongst temples and ruins, this visit enriches the soul, intertwining the luxury of travel with the depth of cultural heritage. Hoa Lu played a pivotal role politically as well as culturally for Vietnam during the 10th and 11th centuries, and was the political and cultural centre at that time. Standing amid tall limestone peaks and expansive rice fields, it is easy to see why this former capital of the Dinh and Le dynasties offers travellers a mixture of timeless architecture, and rich legends, with unrivalled beauty. Returning to the train, you are invited to enjoy a leisurely afternoon tea in the cozy onboard restaurant. In the warm, inviting atmosphere, spend a peaceful time relaxing — perhaps playing a board game, reading a book, or enjoying other light activities. Overnight aboard the SJourney Luxury Train



Wednesday 17 March 2027 (B/L) – arrival at Hanoi and farewell to our luxury train and staff

The train is scheduled to reach Hanoi train station at 5:00 am, however we will savour breakfast until 8:30 am, before disembarking at 9:00 am, when check-out procedures commence. We transfer to our hotel in Hanoi City, leave luggage and enjoy a morning sightseeing tour. As the capital of Vietnam, the city is known for its centuries-old architecture and a rich culture with Southeast Asian, Chinese and French influences. At its heart is the chaotic Old Quarter, where the narrow streets are roughly arranged by trade. There are many little temples, including Bach Ma, honouring a legendary horse, plus Đồng Xuân Market, selling household goods and street food. Enjoy a casual luncheon, and visit Hanoi's Train Street - a narrow train bypass in which several times daily sees a train pass close to buildings on either side of the tracks. It is situated along the alley of Điện Biên Phủ and Phùng Hưng streets, and the main Hanoi Railway Station. We then check in to our hotel. The late afternoon and dinner are at leisure. Overnight Hanoi.



Thursday 18 March 2027 (B/D) – Hanoi

Enjoy a day of sightseeing in Hanoi - around Hoàn Kiếm Lake locals practice tai chi and vendors ladle out steaming bowls of phở. The morning air is cool and soft, perfect for wandering the Old Quarter's tight streets, where each lane hints at its historic trade—silk, silver, herbs—while balconies drip with plants and life spills onto the pavement. A pause for strong Vietnamese coffee, dark and slow, sets the tone before diving deeper into the city's layered past. Late morning brings calm and contrast at the Temple of Literature, where shaded courtyards and stone stelae honour centuries of scholarship, followed by the austere dignity of Ba Đình Square and the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum area, offering insight into modern Vietnamese identity. Lunch is informal and delicious, perhaps—bún chả or bánh cuốn at a no-frills spot—before a quieter afternoon strolling the French Quarter, its wide boulevards and faded colonial villas lending a different, almost European pace to the city. Tonight enjoy a farewell dinner, and overnight Hanoi.




Friday 19 March 2027 (B) – to Australia or beyond

SJR prides itself on its personal service and attention to detail. The tour is escorted by the organiser/s of the itinerary. You are assured of the utmost service and our commitment to your satisfaction. We recognise that each passenger has different interests, and we will aim to provide the opportunity to allow you to rest from the group, explore by yourself or visit special sites you've read about – if you wish. Detailed advice and assistance will be given to help you, and most travel requirements can be made for you.

FARES AND BOOKING PROCEDURES

The tour is limited in size, with a maximum of 20 participants, with bookings confirmed in order of receipt of a deposit of \$3,000 per person. **The tour fare is \$16,650* per person (double/twin share) plus airfares from Australia. Sole use of hotel rooms and sole use of a SJourney Train Cabin is available at a supplement from \$8,980 pp.** The tour fare includes all hotels and sightseeing, rail and coach travel as indicated; all accommodation on a double/twin share basis (single accommodation is available on payment of the single supplement); sightseeing and entrance fees to sites as indicated, and meals as shown in the itinerary for each day. The fare does not include meals not identified, drinks, excess baggage charges, telephone calls, laundry, any items of a personal nature, travel outside the organised group. Due to the variety of interests of individuals, and the range of sites, museums etc. available for inspection on some days, we have included key features in the tour cost. Inspection and entry fees when not part of the planned group activity are not included in the tour cost.

Bookings will be accepted on the attached form. **Changes to the itinerary** - as the tour involves travel in Vietnam and Cambodia, where the situation can change for a range of factors beyond the control of the tour operator, SJR reserves the right to change and amend the itinerary at their sole discretion based on necessary changes to travel plans due to air, sea and land condition changes and hotel availability. Full details of the Terms and Conditions are available on request. An insurance proposal is available at the time of booking. **Cancellation** fees apply as follows: the initial deposit is non-refundable. After further payments for the tour are made, cancellation more than 181 days will be charged 30% of the rail fare component; cancellations made more than 120 days but less than 181 days will be charged 60% of the rail cruise component. No refund will be provided for cancellations made less than 120 days prior to the tour commencing. Costs for tickets, accommodation, sightseeing etc made on your behalf will incur cancellation charges equal to the cancellation charges incurred to us, imposed by suppliers/operators, plus a fee to cover administrative costs – more than three months prior to departure, \$1000 per person; within three months, \$2000 per person. All cancellation or administration charges imposed by the suppliers/operators of components of this tour must be borne by you, the passenger.
